### Interpretation of Achievement Scale – Reading Level 2

*The goals of Reading Level 2 are for students to continue to strengthen their reading comprehension of both academic texts and other material and to continue to build their vocabulary base. By the end of Reading Level 2, students will be able to:*

--Read and comprehend level-appropriate discourses of longer lengths. (R2.1-R2.11)

--Understand and build upon cultural schema found within level-appropriate discourses. (R2.1-R2.11)

#### Pre-Midterm

  - 1.8. Understand discourse markers.
  - 1.9. Reinforce long-term reading memory through SSR.
