--Demonstrate a proficiency score of 75 or higher on the TOEFL iBT. (T4.1-T4.22)

TOEFL Level 4 Teaching Objective:

- 1. Reinforce students' familiarity with the format and skills of the TOEFL iBT as well as test-taking strategies in Reading, Writing, Listening, and Speaking in the integrated style of the iBT format.

• Respond effectively with an opinion to a "problem-solution" speaking prompt. (T4.16)
• Correctly identify negative facts and discern their meaning. (T4.17)
• Correctly identify inferred information in a reading/listening passage. (T4.18)
• Correctly identify the author's purpose in reading passages. (T4.19)
• Accurately complete a table or chart with information provided in a reading/listening passage. (T4.20)
• Orally paraphrase an announcement, lecture, or reading passage. (T4.21)
• Orally summarize an announcement, lecture, or reading passage. (T4.22)

3. Students must receive a score of 80 on the Final Exam Series AND a Preparedness Score of 80%
4. Students must receive a score of 75 on the Final Exam Series AND a Preparedness Score of 85%
